

**WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE
PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE
June 10, 2009; 4:00 P.M.**

Public Safety Members Present: Commissioners John Salmon, Jack Vincent, Earl Wright, and Dale Overton.

Public Safety Members Absent: Commissioners Roger Stewart and Kevin McAlpin.

The Public Safety Committee met on Wednesday, June 10, 2009 at 4:00 p.m. at the Weakley County Department of Finance in the conference room. Others present included Shawn Francisco-Director of Finance, Keith Jones-Juvenile Service Officer, Pam Belew-Circuit Court Clerk, Susan Collins-Clerk & Master, Commissioner Larry Taylor, and Jamison Peevyhouse-EMA Director.

Chairman Jack Vincent called the meeting to order.

OLD BUSINESS:

Commissioner Salmon made the motion to approve the May 13, 2009 minutes and with a second by Commissioner Overton the motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

Transfer 0809-29

The purpose of the transfer is to move funds in the Juvenile budget. Commissioner Wright made the motion to approve the budget transfer and with a second by Commissioner Overton the motion passed unanimously.

Transfer 0809-30

The purpose of the transfer is to move funds in the Sheriff and Jail budgets. Commissioner Wright made the motion to approve the budget transfer and with a second by Commissioner Salmon the motion passed unanimously.

Resolution 2009-44

The purpose of the resolution is to realign revenues for the fiscal year. Commissioner Overton made the motion to approve the budget resolution and with a second by Commissioner Salmon the motion passed unanimously.

Commissioners began reviewing the 2009-10 budgets.

Circuit Court & General Sessions Budget 09-10 FY

Pam Belew presented these budgets. Line item #709 data processing equipment, in both budgets, includes the purchase of new software and equipment to be installed in January 2010. These line items are funded with the data processing reserve funds. Commissioner Wright made the motion to approve these budgets and with a second by Commissioner Salmon the motion passed unanimously.

Chancery Court Budget 09-10FY

Susan Collins presented the Chancery budget. She stated that no changes are requested for the upcoming fiscal year. Commissioner Salmon made the motion to approve the budget and with a second by Commissioner Wright the motion passed unanimously.

Juvenile Court Budget 09-10 FY

Keith Jones presented the Juvenile Court, Truancy, and Meth budgets. The Juvenile budget is a combination of the truancy and juvenile court budgets due to the reduction of the truancy grant by the State of TN. The Truancy budget has been reduced to \$62,747. The Meth budget has been reduced to \$170,000. Commissioner Wright made the motion to approve these budgets and with a second by Commissioner Salmon the motion passed unanimously.

Dispatchers Budget 09-10FY

Jamison Peevyhouse presented the dispatchers budget. The budget includes 10 full time positions plus 2 part time positions. Commissioner Salmon made the motion to approve the budget and with a second by Commissioner Wright the motion passed unanimously.

Emergency Management Budget 09-10FY

Jamison Peevyhouse presented the EMA budget which includes the public safety budget. Two grants for the new year are also included. Commissioner Salmon made the motion to approve these budgets and with a second by Commissioner Overton the motion passed unanimously.

Sheriff and Jail Budgets 09-10 FY

Sheriff Wilson could not be present at today's meeting. However, the committee reviewed the budget. Commissioner Overton made the motion to approve these budgets and with a second by Commissioner Wright the motion passed unanimously.

Volunteer Fire Departments, Rescue Squad, and County Corner

The budget includes appropriations for the five volunteer departments in Weakley County. Also included is the contribution to the Rescue Squad. Commissioner Salmon made the motion to approve these budgets and with a second by Commissioner Wright the motion passed unanimously.

Drug Control Fund Budget 09-10 FY

Sheriff Wilson could not be present at today's meeting. However, the committee reviewed the budget. Commissioner Salmon made the motion to approve these budgets and with a second by Commissioner Wright the motion passed unanimously.

Capital Outlay

Commissioner Salmon addressed the committee regarding the possible acquisition of the Weakley County Municipal Electric building in Dresden. WCMES will be locating to their new facility in the fall. Commissioner Salmon stated that he would like the committee to study the re-location of the Juvenile Court office to this building. Discussion continued.

Commissioner Wright made the motion to adjourn and with a second by Commissioner Salmon the meeting adjourned at 4:48 p.m.
