**OLD BUSINESS:**

Commissioner Salmon made the motion to approve the June 10, 2009 minutes with a second by Commissioner McAlpin the motion passed unanimously.

Keith Jones requested the committee tour the building to be vacant in the next few weeks by Weakley County Municipal Electric System located downtown Dresden. Mr. Jones is requesting the building to be renovated for the Juvenile Court system.

Chief Dudley & Hutcherson spoke about the new state regulations governing firemen training requirements. Senator Herron had opted Weakley County out the state requirement to meet these new standards. However, all Weakley County fire departments are already in compliance with the new requirements and wish to be included in the law. Commissioner Wright made the motion to draft a resolution to be presented to the full commission to include Weakley County into the new state firemen training requirements and with a second by Commissioner Stewart the motion passed unanimously.
