

RESOLUTION TO INSTALL A VENTILATION SYSTEM IN THE WEAKLEY COUNTY JAIL.

WHEREAS, an unsatisfactory condition exists in the Weakley County Jail which is detrimental to the health of inmates; and,

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Department of Correction has informed the Sheriff's Department of this condition; and,

WHEREAS, Paragraph 2.011, Section II of the MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES requires a forced-air ventilation system; and,

WHEREAS, the Quarterly Court Property Committee has had a study made including plans and specifications to correct this deficiency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Quarterly Court in regular session at its April, 1975 term, authorizes the County Property Committee to take the necessary action to install a forced-air ventilation system in the Weakley County Jail.

BE IT, FURTHER RESOLVED that the FY 1974-75 General Fund be amended as follows:
