

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE MARTIN
TO PREPARE THE AREA WIDE FACILITY PLAN

WHEREAS, one of the conditions for wastewater treatment facilities grant applications under Section PL 92-500, is the preparation of a "facilities plan," and

WHEREAS, the 201 Facility Planning Area designated by the the Tennessee Department of Public Health, Division of Water Quality Control is the Came Creek Basin from its headwaters to the Weakley-Obion County line, and

WHEREAS, regulations for "facilities plans" as published by the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (E.P.A.) provide that where a planning area covers several political jurisdictions, the Step 1 Grant (preliminary planning) may be made to joint applicants representing such jurisdictions or to one applicant who has obtained the necessary legal agreements from the other jurisdictions to carry out the contemplated treatment works, and

WHEREAS, it would be beneficial for Weakley County to agree that the City of Martin should prepare the required "facility plan,"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Court of Weakley County, Tennessee, to authorize the City of Martin to prepare the areawide facilities plan and to agree to cooperate fully with Martin in the preparation of the facilities plan.
