

RESOLUTION NO. 1975-35

WHEREAS, the 1974 Tennessee Legislature authorized a salary increase for all county officials, effective Sept. 1, 1975. This salary increase is based on the average consumer price index change for the previous calendar year, and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Court Clerk, Trustee, Register of Deeds, Clerk and Master of Chancery Court and Circuit Court Clerk have decrees from the chancery court, serving Weakley County, to increase the salaries of the deputies of their offices based on the same average consumer price index as authorize the county officials by the Tennessee Legislature, and

WHEREAS, the Comptroler of the State of Tennessee has determined that the average consumer price index increased 11% during the calendar year ending December 31, 1974, over the previous year, and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Quarterly Court adopted a budget for the fiscal year 1975-76, authorizing a salary increase of 2½% for all county employees, except school teachers who received \$150.00 per year increase from the State of Tennessee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Quarterly court in regular session this the 13th day of Oct. 1975, that the following action be taken regarding salary increases in Weakley County:

1. That the Weakley County Attorney file suit in the Chancery Court serving Weakley County on behalf of the County Judge against each county official as listed in paragraph 2 of the resolution to reduce the salary increase, effective Sept. 1, 1975, for deputy assistance in their respective office to the same increase, 2½%, as authorize other county employees.

2. That the elected officials of the office named in paragraph 2 of this resolution limit thier salary increase, effective Sept. 1, 1975, to 2½%.
