

RESOLUTION NO. 1976-54:

A Resolution to Amend the 1976-77
Weakley County General Fund.

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Election Commission requested funds in the amount of \$3,600.00 for a Deputy Registrar-at-large; and,

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Quarterly Court Budget Committee, in an attempt to retain the same property tax rate as the previous year, recommended to the Quarterly Court the same amount for this line item as the previous year, \$1,200.00; and,

WHEREAS, The Weakley County Quarterly Court approved the Budget Committee's recommendation for the FY 1976-77 Budget; and,

WHEREAS, the members of the Weakley County Election Commission have determined that the appropriation of \$1,200.00, for the Deputy Registrar-at-large, is not sufficient for proper and adequate administration of the duties of the office of the election commission and request that the Weakley County Quarterly Court amend the 1976-77 General Fund Budget, Line Item # 203.23, by adding \$2,400.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Quarterly Court in regular session, this the 11th day of October, 1976, that the Weakley County General Fund Budget for the FY 1976-77 be amended as follows:
