

A RESOLUTION to Amend the Appropriation Budget of the General Fund for the Fiscal Year 1976-77

WHEREAS, it has been determined that certain funds within the General Fund Appropriation Budget for FY 76-77 are not sufficient for General County Offices to properly serve the public in an efficient manner; and,

WHEREAS, the office holders of the offices concerned have appeared before the Weakley County Quarterly Court Budget Committee Requesting the following funds;

TO THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE WEAKLEY COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMISSION:

The undersigned hereby petition the Weakley County Highway Commission and the County Quarterly Court of Weakley County, Tennessee to take such action as necessary to close a portion of road located in the 19th District.

The section of road to be closed is located and described as follows:

- beginning at the black-top on "Edminston road and running east approximately one-fourth (1/4) mile to the Edminston Farm thence south approximately 1000 yds., to a discarded bridge.

The aforesaid road does not touch the lands of any person other than the undersigned and no other person uses the same and the closure of said road could not affect the right of interest of any other person.

The aforesaid road is no longer used as a public road and has not been considered by the County Highway Department as a public road for many years.

PETITIONERS PRAYS that the County Highway Commission take favorable action on this petition at its next meeting, to the end that the matter may be submitted to the County Quarterly Court at its next meeting,
