

RESOLUTION NO. 1995-49

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO THE COUNTY HIGHWAY FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1995

WHEREAS, certain events have occurred requiring adjustments in the 1994-95 Highway Fund Budget. Fund # 131
