

RESOLUTION NO. 1997-59

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE
GENERAL FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1997.**

WHEREAS, a gas heating unit at the Election Commission Building has been in service since the early 1960's; and

WHEREAS, said heating unit was condemned by West Tennessee Gas Company and the remaining unit could not adequately heat the building; and

WHEREAS, a new heating unit needed to be installed immediately as an unanticipated expenditure coming from a budgeted line item devised for maintenance and repair of heating/air conditioning equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on this the 17th day of March, 1997 in Dresden, Tennessee that:

SECTION 1. The Weakley County, General Fund is hereby amended as follows:


