

Resolution No. 1998- 45
 Resolution Authorizing Budget Amendments
 To The General Purpose School Fund
 For The Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1998

WHEREAS, certain events have occurred requiring adjustments in the 1997-98 General Purpose School (Special Education) fund; and,

WHEREAS, federal funds have been made available to the General Purpose Fund to compensate the Special Education Fund for transportation costs for two students attending West Tennessee School for the Deaf and are to be budgeted in the 1997-98 school year.
