

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-33
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO THE
WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE HIGHWAY FUND
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2000

WHEREAS, certain events have occurred requiring adjustments in the 1999-2000 Highway Fund Budget, Fund # 131 and,

WHEREAS, a transfer from fund balance is needed to complete the purchase of a complete new radio system for the Highway Department.

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$ 15,000.00 need to be transferred to Communications.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 20th day of March, 2000 in Dresden, Tennessee that this resolution is hereby approved for funds to be transferred to Communications from fund balance.

SECTION 1. The Weakley County Highway Fund is hereby amended as follows:


