

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-40

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENT
TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE GENERAL FUND
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2000.

WHEREAS, changes in the 1999-2000 FY budget are necessary due to the recent relocation of the Weakley County Department of Finance; and

WHEREAS, no money has been appropriated for utilities, pest controls, also funds are needed to replace wheels on office chairs that are damaging the tile floors; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 20th day of March 2000 in Dresden, Tennessee this resolution is hereby approved.






