

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-43

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TRANSFERS OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY AMONG GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES

WHEREAS, Section 12-3-1005. T.C.A. permits counties to purchase, trade, or receive as a gift, upon approval of the governing bodies involved in the transaction, any used or surplus personal property; and from another county, municipality, metropolitan government, state government, federal government or any instrumentality of the foregoing, without regard to any laws regarding public advertisement and competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, this section also permits any county by resolution of its governing body to establish a procedure for the disposition of its surplus personal property to other government entities by sale, gift, trade, or barter upon such terms as the governing body may authorize, without regard to any other provisions of law regarding the sale or disposition of used or surplus personal property.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 20th day of March, 2000 in Dresden, Tennessee this resolution is hereby approved.

SECTION 1. That the various department heads, with the approval of their governing boards in the case of the School and Highway Departments, may dispose of surplus or used personal property and purchase used or surplus personal property from other governmental entities including but not limited to, counties municipalities, metropolitan governments, the State of Tennessee, the federal government and the instrumentalities of any of the foregoing, by sale, gift, trade or barter without regard to any other provisions of law regarding the sale or disposition of used or surplus personal property.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare require in it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.
