

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-47

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENT  
TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE GENERAL FUND  
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2000.

WHEREAS, Weakley County is the recipient of the Tennessee Arts Commission Technical Assistance Grant;  
and

WHEREAS, the grant will be administered by the Northwest Tennessee Development District for the Weakley County Arts and Humanities Council for the purpose of identifying what visual and performing arts opportunities and/or artists in Weakley County; and

WHEREAS, the grant is in the amount of eight hundred and seventy dollars (\$870.00) that will assist 31, 972 individuals with the time period of March 31, 2000 through June 1, 2000; and

WHEREAS, a budget amendment is necessary for the 1999-2000 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 12<sup>th</sup> day of June 2000 in Dresden, Tennessee this resolution is hereby approved.






