

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-07

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND SUPPORTING THE
STUDY AND EXPLORATION OF THE FEASIBILITY,
BENEFITS AND COSTS OF A PRISON IN WEAKLEY
COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Commission is advised that the Joint Economic and Community Development Board for Weakley County, hereinafter referred to as JECDB, has advised that there is a possibility that the State is interested in building a prison in Weakley County; and

WHEREAS, JECDB believes that further study of the costs and benefits of the State's building a prison in Weakley County is needed before a decision in the best interest of the County can be made; and

WHEREAS, JECBD believes that it would be right and proper for the Weakley County Board of Commissioners to adopt a resolution authorizing and supporting the study and exploration of the feasibility, benefits and costs of a prison in Weakley County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Board of Commissioners as follows:

Section 1. **Approval of Study.** JECBD is hereby authorized to study and explore the feasibility, benefits and costs of a prison in Weakley County and to report the results thereof to the Weakley County Board of Commissioners at the completion of said study.

Section 2. **Actions Approved.** All acts and doings of JECBD which are in conformity with the purposes and intents of this Resolution are, in all respects, authorized and approved.

Section 3. **Compliance with Open Meeting Requirements.** This Commission hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Commission, and that all deliberations of this Commission and of its committees which resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.


Section 4. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.




