

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-24

RESOLUTION TO URGE THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO ENACT A PRIVATE ACT PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN COMPENSATION OF THE WEAKLEY COUNTY BOARD OF HIGHWAY COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, the present compensation for the Board of Highway Commissioners for Weakley County is governed by Chapter 640 of the Private Acts of 1949, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the compensation of the Board of Highway Commissioners has not been increased in several years; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Highway Commissioners will be reduced from five to three beginning September 1, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee must enact a Private Act to allow this increase which must be ratified by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the County legislative body; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County have determined it to be in the best interest of Weakley County to provide for this increase from \$200.00 per month to \$300.00 per month for each commissioner.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 19th day of November, 2001 in Dresden, Tennessee that the members of the General Assembly representing Weakley County are urged to introduce and work for the passage of the private act attached hereto which would increase the compensation of the Board of Highway Commissioners of Weakley County from \$200.00 to \$300.00 per month.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be mailed by the County Clerk to the members of the General Assembly representing Weakley County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 640 of the Private Acts of 1949, as amended by Chapter 546 of the Private Acts of 1951, Chapter 239 of the Private Acts of 1953, Chapter 250 of the Private Acts of 1953, Chapter 106 of the Private Acts of 1957, Chapter 14 and 73 of the Private Acts of 1965. Chapter 444 of the Private Acts of 1967, Chapters 23 and 24 and the Private Acts of 1971, Chapter 60 of the Private Acts of 1979, Chapter 33 of the Private Acts of 1995, and all other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the compensation of the county highway commission of Weakley County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 640 of the Private Acts of 1949, as amended by Chapter 250 of the Private Acts of 1953, Chapter 24 of the Private Acts of 1971, Chapter 60 of the Private Acts of 1979 and Chapter 33 of the Private Acts of 1995, is further amended by deleting the following language:

“which compensation shall not be less than two hundred dollars (\$200) per month” and substituting instead the following:

“which compensation shall not be less than three hundred dollars (\$300) per month for any term beginning on or after September 1, 2002.”

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the county legislative body of Weakley County. Its approval or non-approval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the county legislative body of Weakley County and certified to the Secretary of State.


SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective upon being approved as provided in Section 7.

MOTION TO RECONSIDER RESOLUTION NO. 2002-24

Commissioner McAlpin placed a motion to reconsider Resolution No. 2002-24 due to the fact that it failed to pass the November 19, 2001 Commission by a two-thirds majority vote. Commissioner McAlpin made a motion to place Resolution No. 2002-24 on the floor and Commissioner Rook placed a second. Roll call vote was taken and the Resolution **failed** by a vote of 13 ayes, 5 nays, 1 absent, 0 passed and 1 vacant.

MOTION TO RECONSIDER RESOLUTION NO. 2002-24 BY FULL COMMISSION, JANUARY 22, 2002


