

**RESOLUTION NO. 2003-12
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR
THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE HIGHWAY FUND
LITTER AND TRASH COLLECTION
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2003**

WHEREAS, more revenue than anticipated will be received from the Tennessee Dept. of Transportation For the Litter and Trash Collection Grant and,

WHEREAS, this budget amendment is to realign the revenue received from Tennessee Dept. of Transportation Litter Grant Division which is \$ 18,705.00 and,

WHEREAS, the amount originally set up in the 2002-03 budget needs to be increased by \$18,705 which will be a total of \$44,952 to be received as revenue and,

WHEREAS, the creation of a new line is needed in this grant to expenditure funds for other supplies and materials and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 25th day of November, 2002 in Dresden, Tennessee that this resolution is hereby approved to increase revenue and create a line item in the Litter and Trash Collection Grant.


