

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN GENERAL FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2003

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Jail has been housing a higher than estimated inmate population for the 2002-03 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Weakley County is responsible for the medical welfare of these inmates; and

WHEREAS, additional funds need to be transferred from the Sheriff budget to the Jail budget to complete the 2002-03 fiscal year; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 19th of May 2003 in Dresden, Tennessee that:

SECTION 1. The Weakley County General Fund is hereby amended as follows:
