**RESOLUTION 2004 - 23**

**RESOLUTION TO DONATE SURPLUS WEAKLEY COUNTY REAL ESTATE  
TO THE PALMERSVILLE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS,** the Weakley County Board of Education previously granted to the Palmersville community permission to move the one-room school building, known as Webb School to the grounds of the Palmersville School; and

**WHEREAS,** the lot used for the Webb School is leased to the Palmersville Volunteer Fire Department by the Weakley County Board of Education to preserve this Weakley County historic building and for the use and benefit of the Palmersville Volunteer Fire Department; and

**WHEREAS,** the Palmersville School property has been sold with the exception of the lot referred to above whereon is located the Webb School building; and


**WHEREAS,** the Weakley County School Board has voted unanimously to transfer the aforesaid lot to Weakley County by resolution for disposition by Weakley County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Weakley County Legislative Body meeting in Regular Session at Dresden, Tennessee, on this 15th day of March 2004, that the lot on which the old Webb School building is located, being the same lot that was staked and reserved when the Palmersville School property was sold, shall be transferred by deed to the Palmersville Volunteer Fire Department, a fire department certified by the State Fire Marshall under the laws of the State of Tennessee, for the use and benefit of said Palmersville Volunteer Fire Department and, through it, for the use and benefit of the citizens of Weakley County and the preservation of a part of our heritage.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that this resolution shall take effect upon passage by a two thirds majority of the members of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee.


