

RESOLUTION 2004 - 31

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS
TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE GENERAL FUND
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2004**

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated § 16-1-117 states that it is the duty of the administrative offices of the courts to collect, develop, and maintain uniform statistical information relative to court caseloads in Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated § 16-1-117(c) allows assistance to the court clerks in reporting the information required by this section and to encourage modernization and computerization of their offices; and

WHEREAS, the revenue from the fee for data entry levied in Tennessee Code Annotated § 8-21-401(e) shall be allocated by the clerk's county for computerization information systems and electronic management costs of the clerk's office, including, but not limited to, the purchase, upgrade, and maintenance costs of computer equipment; and

WHEREAS, these revenues are placed into the Reserved for Automation-Chancery Court reserve account in the County General Fund at fiscal year end; and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Chancery Court is in need of the funds in the Reserved for Automation-Chancery Court account to purchase new computers for the Clerk and Master's office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Legislative Body meeting in Regular Session at Dresden, Tennessee, on this 17th day of May, 2004, that:

SECTION 1. The Weakley County General Fund is hereby amended as follows:


