RESOLUTION BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF WEAKLEY COUNTY
RATIFYING THE AMENDED WEAKLEY COUNTY GROWTH PLAN
DATED OCTOBER 19, 2004

WHEREAS, the Dresden, Gleason, Greenfield, Martin and Sharon Planning Commissions have determined that their existing or amended Urban Growth Boundaries are reasonably compact out large enough to accommodate growth during the next twenty years; and,

WHEREAS, that Dresden, Gleason, Greenfield, Martin and Sharon Planning Commissions have determined that their cities are better able than other areas to efficiently provide urban services to the area within their existing or proposed Urban Growth Boundary; and,

WHEREAS, the Dresden, Gleason, Greenfield, Martin and Sharon Planning Commissioners have determined that their existing or proposed Urban Growth Boundary are contiguous to their existing municipal boundaries; and,

WHEREAS, the Dresden, Gleason, Greenfield, Martin and Sharon Planning Commissions have identified territory that any reasonable and prudent person would project as the likely growth areas over the next twenty years; and,

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Coordinating Committee has approved the amended Weakley County Growth Plan dated October 19, 2004.

WHEREAS, the County of Weakley held two public hearings on Sept. 09, 2004 at 4:00 p.m. and on Oct. 04, 2004 at 4:00 p.m.; and,
