

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS  
TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN DRUG CONTROL FUND  
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2005**

**WHEREAS**, all Weakley County Sheriff officers are provided with a firearm, a lethal device; and

**WHEREAS**, for the safety of the Weakley County officers and the protection of the offender, there is a need for a less lethal devices, tasers; and

**WHEREAS**, tasers will allow Weakley County Sheriff officers to disable a suspect from a distance without increasing the danger for the officer or innocent bystanders.

**WHEREAS**, drug control funds are available for the purchase of tasers.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 17<sup>th</sup> of January 2005 in Dresden, Tennessee that:

**SECTION 1.** The Weakley County Drug Control Fund is hereby amended as follows:


