RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SPEED LIMIT
IN DUKEDOM, TENNESSEE**

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented to the Weakley County Board of Highway Commissioners at the March 10, 2005 meeting for the purpose of establishing a speed limit on County Line Road in Dukedom and;

WHEREAS, this resolution is requesting the speed limit be set at 45 M.P.H. It will begin at the intersection of Hwy. 118 and turning east traveling approximately 1 mile and;

WHEREAS, the passing of this resolution would create a safe speed limit in the community and deter the excessive rate of speed used at the present time by the traveling public entering Dukedom.





