

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS
TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN GENERAL FUND
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2005**

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$3,300 have been requested from the TN Department of Health Weakley County savings to replace a central unit at the Weakley County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, the Dresden Office on Aging has received additional grant funds for the 2004-05 fiscal year due to the increased units of participation service in the respite, personal care, and family caregivers programs;




