RESOLUTION TO RECOGNIZE COUNTY VETERANS SERVICE OFFICER WILLIAM D. (DAVE) BRADLEY UPON HIS RETIREMENT

WHEREAS, William D. (Dave) Bradley served in the U. S. Army for 23 years, with 11 years on foreign soil, and achieved the rank of Master Sergeant; and

WHEREAS, he was assigned as a helicopter crew-chief and gunner in combat with 1st Cavalry Division in Vietnam and the Dominican Republic and six (6) years with the U. S. Army Executive Flight Detachment in Washington, DC in direct support of the White House; and

WHEREAS, Dave Bradley was awarded two (2) Bronze Star Medals, 15 Air Medals, three (3) Army Commendation Medals and 19 other decorations, awards and medals; and

WHEREAS, Dave Bradley has served his fellow veterans as the Weakley County Veterans Service Officer since 1998 until he retires on June 30, 2005; and

WHEREAS, during Mr. Bradley's tenure the average daily case load has increased from three (3) in 1998 to almost seven (7) in 2004; and


WHEREAS, the monetary awards to veterans and/or family members in Weakley County increased from just over \$900,000 in FY 1997-98 to over \$1,250,000 in FY 2002-03.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect upon passage by a majority of the members of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County






