RESOLUTION NO. 2006-12

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM ESTABLISHED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR USE BY ALL RESPONDERS TO ANY EMERGENCY, BOTH NATURAL AND MANMADE, OCCURRING IN WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has developed the National Incident Management System, and all Federal emergency funding and grants are conditioned upon adoption of such system, and

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee has adopted the National Incident Management System and has directed all political subdivisions of the state to adopt the National Incident Management System, and

WHEREAS, the various agencies managing emergency incidents in Weakley County have utilized various management systems.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Legislative Body meeting in regular session in Dresden, Tennessee, on this the 19th day of September, 2005:

SECTION 1. That the county of Weakley hereby adopts the National Incident Management System established by the United States Department of Homeland Security for the management of all emergency incidents by all departments and agencies of the county of Weakley, Tennessee.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect upon passage by a majority of the members of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee.
