

RESOLUTION 2006-24

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE COLLECTION OF FEES, FINES, COURT COSTS AND OTHER CHARGES BY DEBIT AND CREDIT CARDS IN WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, the use of debit and credit cards for payment for goods, services, and other obligations is a common business practice in today's economy; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated §8-21-107 authorizes the various clerks of court responsible for the collection of fees, fines, court costs or other charges to accept payment by debit or credit cards; and

WHEREAS, the authorization of payment by debit or credit cards would be a convenience to the taxpayers and enhance revenue collections for the county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County meeting in regular session, this the 21st day of November, 2005, that the County Clerk, Circuit Court Clerk, General Session Court Clerk, and Clerk and Master are authorized to accept debit or credit cards for payment of fees, fines, court costs, or other charges.

SECTION 1. To cover the expenses incurred in processing the payment by debit or credit cards, a processing fee in the amount of five percent (5%) of the amount of the fee, court costs or other charge being paid shall be charged.

SECTION 2. In the event a payment by debit or credit card is not honored by the credit card company on which the funds are drawn, the clerk may collect a service charge from the person who owes the fee, fine, court cost or other charge. The service charge is in addition to the original fee, fine, court costs or other charge and is for the collection of that original amount. The amount of the service charge shall be the same amount as the fee charged for the collection of a check drawn on an account with insufficient funds.

SECTION 3. The clerk collecting a fee or charge under this chapter shall deposit the fee or charge in the County General Fund.

SECTION 4 The clerk collecting a fee or charge shall state on any notice to the taxpayer either the percentage of the processing fee or the fee itself.

SECTION 5. The clerk collecting a fee or charge shall state on any notice to the taxpayer either the percentage of the processing fee for use of a debit or credit card or the actual fee imposed for the use of a debit or credit card.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the county legislative body.
