RESOLUTION TO APPROVE CONTRACT WITH
STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the State Department of Transportation proposes to construct a project designated as No. 92139-2202-04; State Route 216 extension from State Route 43/372 south of Martin to State Route 22 east of Martin at Ralston (3.645 miles) in Weakley County, provided Weakley County agrees to cooperate with the State Department of Transportation as set forth in the attached proposal, so that the general highway program be carried out in accordance with the intent of the General Assembly of the State; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County believes that it would be in the best interest of Weakley County to enter into the attached contract with the State Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on the 16th day of July, 1990, that:

1. The County Executive is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to sign the attached contract on behalf of Weakley County.
2. This resolution shall take effect upon passage, the public welfare requiring it.
