

MINUTES
SEPT. 6, 2007

The Weakley County Board of Highway Commissioners held their regular monthly meeting on Thursday, Sept. 6, 2007 at 5:00 p.m. at the Highway Dept. Public Works Committee present was Commissioners Taylor, Barner, Sinclair, Farmer, Medling and Rook and Road Board Commissioners Mansfield and Robinson attended. Commissioner Bell was absent. Supervisor Hopper and Landa Harris, Sec. was present.

Chairman Mansfield called the meeting to order and Commissioner Medling opened with prayer for our county. The chair was given to Supervisor Hopper so that the Road Board could have a quorum. Minutes were approved as read by Commissioner Robinson and second by Commissioner Mansfield. Motion carried.

Old Business: The Cat dozer has been ordered from Thompson Machinery who was low bidder at approximately \$269,000.

Mr. George Bunch is in the process of obtaining signatures to have his road placed on the county maintenance system. There was a lengthy discussion of specifications of placing roads on the maintenance system.

New Business: A letter was presented from Como Fire Department requesting help in digging a couple of dry wells with our backhoe. It was decided that we would accommodate them since the county helps finance the Fire Department. Motion by Commissioner Mansfield that we help them by furnishing our backhoe and operator and Commissioner Robinson second. Motion carried.

Res. # 2008-11 was presented to the Road Board and Public Works Committee for their approval on State Aid Funds revenue and expenditure increase causing a deficit of - \$39,350 which can be taken from fund balance leaving a balance of \$107,474. Motion made by Commissioner Robinson and second by Commissioner Mansfield., Motion carried.

Res. 2008-07 was presented concerning naming a bridge in memory of Charlie Damron. This bridge is on Adams Rd. near Martin. It will be Charlie Damron Memorial Bridge. Motion made by Commissioner Mansfield and second by Commissioner Robinson. Motion carried.

There being no further business, Commissioner Robinson made a motion to adjourn and Commissioner Mansfield second. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
