

RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE COUNTY GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2011.

WHEREAS, Weakley County has recently sold a parcel of property in Gleason, Tennessee known as the Oliver Machine and Welding property that was acquired for nonpayment of taxes by the previous owner for \$14,025; and

WHEREAS, Weakley County has a claim for delinquent personal property taxes filed in the office of Clerk & Master in the amount of \$1,258.88 including certain costs and fees due the Clerk & Master; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gleason has a claim for delinquent personal property taxes in the amount of \$786.51 and a claim for delinquent real estate taxes in the amount of \$3,225.85 including certain costs and fees due the Clerk and Master and another \$435.90 due to the City of Gleason for 2010 real estate taxes not filed.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 30th day of June, 2011 in Dresden, Tennessee that the proceeds of the sale be credited to the Weakley County General Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County General Fund be amended by \$14,025 to revenue account #101-44540 Sale of Property and expenditure account #101-58400.599 Other Charges in order for the City of Gleason and the Clerk & Master of Weakley County to receive funds due them.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.
