

Polling Location Changes for Weakley County Elections in 2012

1A Palmersville Fire Station to Palmersville Pirate Creek Community Church (old Palmersville School) .

5A Martin Buster Williams Fire Station to Martin Church of Christ (233 Oxford St.)

7A Martin Vincent Implement Company to Martin Shepherd's Field Church (120 South Ave.)

9A Dresden Senior Citizens Center to Dresden First Baptist Church (490 Morrow St.)

Other Polling Locations for voting in Weakley County:

1B Latham Fire Department

2A Gleason Community Building

3A Greenfield Park Pavilion

4A Sharon Fire Station

6A Martin Trinity Presbyterian Church, 145 Hannings Lane (next to U.T.M. Dorms)

8A Martin Methodist Church, 225 Main St. (near Claire & Schuster Interiors in Martin)

The above are polling locations which have been secured for the 2012 Elections.

T.C.A. 2-3-101 says if a county election commission determines that there is no place within a precinct to hold an election – the election may be held no more than ½ mile from the precinct boundary as the polling place.

T.C.A. 2-3-105 says after any change of precinct boundaries or change of district, the County Election Commission shall publish the changed boundaries in a newspaper of general circulation in the county. The county election commission shall mail to each active voter whose polling place has been changed a notice of the voter's new polling place and the precinct number. Also any changes shall be given to the office of local government, comptroller of the treasury.
