**Resolution Authorizing Budget Amendments To The Weakley County, TN
General Fund For The Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2019**

WHEREAS, the Weakley County General Fund budget 18-19 is in need of realignment in estimated expenditures to purchase of a new printer in the office that oversees the sex offenders registry, to move an employee's salary increase to the correct line, and to add funding in the budget for the county contribution to a new employee's Health Savings Account.
