RESOLUTION NO. 1996-32

RESOLUTION TO URGE THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO ENACT SENATE BILL NO. 2691, HOUSE BILL NO. 2928, REGARDING MUNICIPAL CONDEMNATION PROCEDURES

WHEREAS, the current law regarding municipal condemnation proceedings does not address the interests of neighboring county governments when a municipality attempts to condemn property in neighboring counties; and

WHEREAS, county governments are currently required to get the approval of 1the neighboring county legislative body before condemning property across county lines; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 2691 by Senator Haun and the companion House Bill No. 2928 by Representative Roach would require municipal governments to obtain the approval of the county legislative body before condemning property in a county other than the county where the municipality is located; and

WHEREAS, this bill would promote fairness by placing the same requirements on cities and counties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session at Dresden, Tennessee, that the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee, is strongly urged to enact Senate Bill No. 2691 by Senator Haun and its companion House Bill No. 2928 by Representative Roach. The county clerk is directed to send certified copies of this Resolution to the members of the General Assembly representing the people of Weakley County.
