RESOLUTION 1996-35

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR ADVISORY SERVICES FOR CERTAIN AD VALOREM ASSESSMENTS IN WEAKLEY COUNTY

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated Section 67-5-507 authorizes the governing body of any county to enter into contracts with individuals, firms or corporations to render advice or assistance to the local tax assessor in the assessment and equalization of taxes, and

WHEREAS, Weakley County has need for the services of an individual or firm to assist the Weakley County Property Assessor in the assessment of certain ad valorem property within the county,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE meeting in regular session on March 18, 1996;

SECTION 1: The Weakley County Commission hereby authorizes the County Executive on behalf of the county to enter into a contract with a qualified individual, firm, or corporation, to undertake examinations of businesses having tangible personal property liable for ad valorem assessments in the county, pursuant to T.C.A. Section 67-5-507.


SECTION 2: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Weakley County Executive shall negotiate reasonable terms and conditions for such contract in consultation with the Assessor of Property, provided that compensation thereunder shall not be paid on a percentage basis, or on any basis whereby the compensation is in anywise dependent or conditioned upon increasing or reducing the aggregate assessment of property in the county.

SECTION 3: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.
