

RESOLUTION NO. 1997-22

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE COUNTY'S PROPOSED REAPPRAISAL PLAN

WHEREAS, Public Chapter 495 of 1989 requires periodic reappraisal of each jurisdiction in Tennessee imposing a property tax, based on an initial schedule developed by the State Board of Equalization; and

WHEREAS, Weakley County has been scheduled for reappraisal by the State Board of Equalization and directed pursuant to Public Chapter 495 to submit a plan of reappraisal; and


WHEREAS, the law requires the governing body of reappraisal jurisdictions to review the reappraisal plan and communicate to the State Board of Equalization whether said governing body approves or disapproves of such plan; and

WHEREAS, the county commission of Weakley County has reviewed the county's proposed reappraisal plan and desires to communicate the results of its review to the State Board of Equalization as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislative Body of Weakley County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on this the 25th day of November, 1996, that said plan of reappraisal is hereby approved and direct that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the State Board of Equalization with such explanatory comments as are approved by the Commission in adopting this resolution.
