## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, HIGHWAY FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1998.

- WHEREAS, this budget amendment is to realign the revenue received from the Highway Department's surplus property sale; and
