

Resolution No. 1998-52

Resolution authorizes budget amendments to the General Fund for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 1998.

WHEREAS, The Juvenile Court has had to hold several minors in secure and partial secure facilities that have been charged with criminal offenses; and

WHEREAS, The Juvenile Court had estimated an expenditure of \$3,680.00 and has currently spent \$3,270 as this date leaving a total of \$410; and

WHEREAS, The court currently has an outstanding balance of \$1,480 for holding costs and is estimated that an additional \$3,000 in holding costs will be needed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on this 20th day of January, 1998, that:

SECTION 1. The General Fund is hereby amended as follows:
