

RESOLUTION NO. 1999-54

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS
TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY, TN GENERAL FUND
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1999.

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Trustee has been informed by the Local Government Data Processing Corporation that the computers in the Trustee's office are not Y2K compliant; and

WHEREAS, a computer upgrade is necessary to be Y2K compliant; and

WHEREAS, the Trustee did not anticipate a computer upgrade when the budget was appropriated; and

WHEREAS, the computer upgrade will cost \$1,286.00 for hardware components and installation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 17th day of May, 1999 in Dresden, Tennessee that:


SECTION 1. The Weakley County, General Fund is hereby amended as follows:




