## **RESOLUTION NO. 2000-41**

## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF THE CONSOLIDATED SERVICE STATION FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE WEAKLEY COUNTY HIGHWAY FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2000.

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Financial Management Committee has determined that the operations of the Consolidated Service Station must be made competitive with private suppliers; and

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Service Station is presently funded from the General Fund of the Weakley County budget; and

WHEREAS, the Financial Management Committee appointed Highway Supervisor Jimmy Freeman to maintain the Consolidated Service Station building and School Superintendent Richard Barber to maintain the computerized pumps at the Consolidated Service Station; and

WHEREAS, the Highway Department purchases 63% of fuel from the Consolidated Service Station, thus the Financial Management Committee elected to place the Consolidated Service Station under the direct supervision of the Weakley County Highway Road Supervisor; and

WHEREAS, funds must be appropriated for the Consolidated Service Station in the Weakley County Highway Fund for the remainder of the 1999-2000 FY; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March 2000 in Dresden, Tennessee that:
