WHEREAS, the Tennessee Legislature has not adopted the final 2000-2001 FY Budget for the State of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, county revenue from the state budget is vital to preparing the Weakley County Revenue and Expenditure Budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 12th day of June, 2000 in Dresden, Tennessee that the adopted Weakley County 2000-2001 General Fund, Highway Fund, Debt Service Fund, Department of Education, and Solid Waste Fund Budgets be adopted as the 2000-2001 FY Tentative Budgets; and

SECTION 1. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that no more than 1/12th of any line item be expended per calendar month by each Department without the approval of the Weakley County Board of Commissioner's Finance, Ways, and Means Committee until the final 2000-2001 FY Budget is adopted.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the, Board of County Commissioners.
