## A RESOLUTION

This Resolution provides the authorization for capital expenditures, not exceeding \$30,000.00, of Weakley County federal revenue sharing funds by Weakley County, Tennessee, for the repair and/or menovation of the Weakley County Courthouse Building.

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Courthouse Building is a structure of approvimately twenty-five years of age and is in a state requiring interior and exterior repairs and/or renovation to preserve and maintain the structure and to prevent further deterioration from inadequate repair and maintenance, and

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Courthouse building and appurtenances thereto is a modern structure and should be preserved and maintained in a stately order. Therefore, repairs, replacements, and/or renovations, interior and exterior should be promptly completed. Repairs, replacements and/or renovation means to include the cleaning, painting, repairing, replacing installation and correction of the interior and exterior, and extends to include the plumbing as well as installation of adequate electrical wiring, or such other mechanical corrections as deemed necessary in the circumstances in order to prepare the entire structure to be totally functional, and
