

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE
AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF A COUNTY PRIVILEGE TAX
ON MARRIAGE LICENSES

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-4202 empowers counties to levy a privilege tax on the issuance of marriage licenses in the same manner and not to exceed the tax levied by the state in T.C.A. § 67-4203 Item 62, and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly has passed and the Governor has signed into law Public Chapter 69 which increases the state privilege tax on marriage licenses, from \$2.00 to \$5.00 effective July 1, 1981.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County meeting in regular session on this 20th day of April, 1981, that:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-4203 a county privilege tax of \$5.00 is hereby levied on marriage licenses. Such tax to be collected by the county clerk in the same manner as the state privilege tax on marriage licenses is collected.

SECTION 2. The county privilege tax of \$5.00 shall become effective July 1, 1981.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that a true copy of this Resolution be spread upon the Commission record of this date.
