RESOLUTION NO. 1982-14

A RESOLUTION MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO NON-PROFIT CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS OF WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1982 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1983.

WHEREAS, Section 5-9-109, Tennessee Code Annotated, authorizes the County Legislative Body to make appropriations to non-profit charitable organizations; and,

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Legislative Body recognizes the various non-profit charitable organizations located in or providing services in Weakley County have great need of funds to carry on their non-profit charitable work,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, on this 19th day of July, 1982.

SECTION 1. That thirty-one hundred dollars (\$3,100.00) be appropriated to the Weakley County Rescue Squad to benefit the general welfare of the residents of Weakley County.

SECTION 2. That twenty-one hundred and fifty dollars (\$2,150.00) be appropriated to the Easter Seal Society for the benefit of handicapped children in Weakley County.

SECTION 3. That seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.00) be appropriated to the West Tennessee Hearing and Speech Center for the benefit of the residents of Weakley County.

SECTION 4. That twelve thousand eight hundred forty dollars (\$12,840.00) be appropriated to the Northwest Tennessee Mental Health Center to benefit the general welfare of the residents of Weakley County.

SECTION 5. That six hundred forty-two dollars (\$642.00) be appropriated to the Jackson area Council on Alcoholism to benefit the general welfare of the residents of Weakley County.

SECTION 6. That ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) be appropriated to the Weakley County Chamber of Commerce to promote the economic development of Weakley County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appropriation enumerated in Section 1 through 6 above is made subject to the following conditions:

1. That the non-profit charitable organization to which funds are appropriated shall file with the disbursing official a copy of an annual report of its business affairs and transactions and the proposed use of the county's funds in accordance with rules promulgated by the
