

TO RESCIND RESOLUTION NO. 21 OF 19 78
REGARDING TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated Section 67-516(b) provides that county legislative bodies may by Resolution approved by two-thirds (2/3) of the membership, direct the local Assessor of Property to presume that tangible personal property owned and used by a business subject to the Business Tax has no value, and

WHEREAS, the county legislative body of Weakley County adopted such a Resolution pursuant to T.C.A. 67-516(b) on the 10th day of July, 1978 at a regular meeting, the minutes of which are of record in Minute Book 2, at page 126, and

WHEREAS, due to recent federal court decisions it is no longer of benefit to Weakley County to operate under this Resolution,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee, in regular session on this 18th day of October 1982, that:

SECTION 1. The Resolution adopted by the county legislative body pursuant to T.C.A. 67-516(b) on the 10th day of July, 1978, recorded in Minute Book 2 at page 126 is hereby expressly rescinded.

SECTION 2. The Assessor of Property is hereby directed to proceed to assess all personal property subject to taxation in Weakley County for the 1982 tax year and all subsequent years, according to law.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Weakley County Board of County Commissioners.
