

RESOLUTION NO. 1986-35

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING NON-DISPLAY OF DECALS

WHEREAS, Chapter 530 of the Public Acts of 1986 requires that county legislative bodies in counties which have levied a motor vehicle privilege tax either pursuant to T.C.A. 5-8-102 or by private act decide whether to require residents who operate motor vehicles in the county to affix a decal or emblem upon the motor vehicle as evidence of compliance, and if so where it is to be affixed, and


WHEREAS, Weakley County has a motor vehicle privilege (wheel) tax levied pursuant to Resolution 1979-32, and

WHEREAS, the county legislative body desires that the aforementioned acts be fully complied with and that residents not be inconvenienced by having to affix decals or emblems,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the board of County Commissioners of Weakley County, Tennessee at a regular meeting, on this 21st day of July, 1986, that residents who operate motor vehicles in Weakley County are not required to affix a decal or emblem as evidence of payment of the motor vehicle privilege (wheel) tax.


