1989-90 TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR THE WEAKLEY COUNTY
GENERAL FUND, WEAKLEY COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT,
DEBT SERVICE FUND AND WEAKLEY COUNTY DEPARTMENT
OF EDUCATION

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Legislature has not adopted the final 1989-90 Budget for the State of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, county revenue from the state budget is vital to prepare the Weakley County Revenue and Expenditure Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Weakley County Board of Commissioners in its regular meeting, this the 17th day of April, 1989, that the adopted Weakley County 1988-89 General Fund, Highway Department, Department of Education and Debt Service Budgets be adopted as the 1989-90 Tentative Budgets; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no more than 1/12th of any line item may be expended per calendar month without the approval of the Weakley County Board of Commissioners' Budget Committee, until the final 1989-90 Budget is adopted.
