Resolution Authorizing Budget Amendments To The Weakley County, TN General Fund For The Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2019

WHEREAS, the Weakley County General Fund budget for FY 2018-19 is in need of realignment in estimated revenue due to the fact that the Weakley County Office on Aging has raised additional funds for the operation of said office and the Dresden Senior Center. Additionally, a realignment of estimated expenditures is needed to compensate a number of county employees for travel expenses resulting from an increase in client referrals from the Northwest Tennessee Development District.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, **BE IT RESOLVED** by the county legislative body of Weakley County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the <u>30th</u> day of <u>May</u>, <u>2019</u>, in Dresden, Tennessee, that:
