County Attorney, William R. Neese gave a report to the County Commissioners concerning the problems with County Government. A letter was given to each Commissioner, one filed with the County Clerk and the County Executive.

Motion to approve the letter and to proceed made by Commissioner Westbrook and seconded by Commissioner Bucy. After discussion an amendment to the motion by Commissioner Phebus to restrain disclosure and seconded by Commissioner Broussard. Voice vote. Aye's carried.

Motion as amended to proceed with the intent of the letter. Voice vote. Aye's carried.

Commissioner Westbrook, gave a report from the Capital Project Committee concerning the school administration building. He also stated that the Capital Project Committee was not prepared to make a recommendation to you at this time as to proceed or not to proceed. There was much discussion about the project from the County Commissioners. Motion was made by Commissioner Westbrook to recess and seconded by Commissioner Wright for April 12, 1999 at 7 P. M. Voice vote. Aye's carried.
