RESOLUTIONS

Resolution No. 2017-47

Previously passed unanimously through the Public Safety Committee, this resolution states that the fee for an inmate of the Weakley County Detention Center should be fixed to be equivalent to the State reimbursement rate but with a minimum fixed rate of no less than thirty-nine dollars (\$39.00) per twenty-four (24) hour period of confinement in the Weakley County Detention Center. Commissioner Westbrook made the motion to approve and recommend Resolution No. 2017-47 to the full county commission, and with a second by Commissioner Wright, the motion passed unanimously.

There was some short conversation about challenges for the courts in collecting fees.

Having no other business, Commissioner Jones made the motion to adjourn the meeting and with a second by Commissioner Wright, the motion passed unanimously.


