The Finance, Ways, and Means Committee met on Thursday, July 28, 2016 at 5:15 p.m. in the county commission courtroom at the court house in Dresden. OLD BUSINESS:

Chairperson Eric Owen called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m. With no minutes to approve, Chairperson Owen moved on to new business.

NEW BUSINESS:

Chairperson Owen recognized County Attorney Allison Whitlege who began by saying that certified mailing had been moved from the Sheriff's Department Budget to the Chancery Court Budget. The necessity for additional funds in the line had been discovered due to the need for additional notices to be sent to defendants for the county's delinquent tax sale. Ms. Whitlege stated that funds for those notices were not included in the projected or anticipated budget for the Chancery Court, and went on to say that when filing with the court to take a motion for default judgment and asking the court to enter an order for sale, new rules require a certificate of service be sent to all defendants.

Commissioner Owen made the motion to add \$3000 to 101-53400-348 (General Fund - Chancery Court - Postage Charges), increasing the funds in the line from \$10,600 to \$13,600 and with a second by Dennis Doster, the motion passed unanimously.


Having no other business, Commissioner Jones made the motion to adjourn and with a second by Commissioner Westbrook, the meeting adjourned at 5:20 p.m.
